



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26**

**REORGANIZING THE MANAGEMENT AND TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE-LED AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES EXTENSION SYSTEM (MPAFES)**

**WHEREAS**, The Province-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension System (PAFES) is one of the key strategies under consolidation pillar of the One DA Reform Agenda that aims to strengthen and establish a collaborative scheme between DA, Local Government Units, academe, the private sector, civil society organizations, farmers and fisher's groups and the other national agencies to bring extension services to the grassroots level amid the challenges of devolution.

**WHEREAS**, This province-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension System (PAFES) will assist and support the Local Government Units to address the challenges that remained overtime and assist in the agricultural delivery functions as mandated by the Local Government Code;

**WHEREAS**, The province have already formulated the flagship initiatives for the Collaborative Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Programs (CPAFEP), and had already established the Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Center to serve as an extension center that synchronizes all agricultural plans and programs as well as orchestrate the activities of the various stakeholders;

**WHEREAS**, The Provincial Local Government Unit (PLGU) have already entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Agriculture thru the Cordillera Administrative Region Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension System Regional Program Management Office represented by the heads of the DA-RFO-CAR, ATI-RTC-CAR and BFAR-CAR, transferring the PAFES fund for the initial operationalization and implementation of the projects and activities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BONIFACIO C. LACWASAN, JR.**, Provincial Governor of Mountain Province by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order the amendment and reorganization of the Mountain Province-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension System (MPAFES) to oversee and provide strategic directions in the operationalization and implementation of the various projects and activities embodied in the Collaborative Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Program (CPAFEP) and to compose of the following membership with their functions;

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### Functions of the Provincial Management Group

1. Responsible in the implementation of the Collaborative Provincial led Agriculture and Extension Plan (CPAFEP).
2. Design implementing guidelines on the establishment of PAFES and mainstream it in the operations of the PLGU and MLGUs.
3. Request for the counterpart financing for PAFES in the regular budget of the PLGU and MLGU for its successful operation.
4. Initiate the creation of the Municipal Management Groups (MMGs).
5. Provide direction to the Municipal Management Groups relative to the implementation of the PAFES.
6. Link the Mountain Province Agriculture and Fisheries Extension System with resource/technology providers within and outside the province.
7. Prepare quarterly reports to the PMC on the progress of PAFEP implementation.

To operationalize and implement the Mountain Province Agriculture and Extension System, the following personnel and staff shall be designated to oversee the center and assist implement the programs and activities in addition to their office functions as follows:

### Function of the Officer In-Charge

1. Supervise the operation of the center and the implementation of the various programs, projects and activities related to the CPAFEP.
2. Coordinate with the concerned DA and its attached agencies and other stakeholders in the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the CPAFEP related activities.
3. Provide quarterly reports relative to the implementation of the CPAFEP to the PMG for their information and appropriate actions.
4. Provide progress reports and other related reports as required by DA and its attached agencies.

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

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**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 25, Series 2022**

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REORGANIZING THE MOUNTAIN PROVINCE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (MPDRMC) AND RECONSTITUTING MEMBERSHIP THEREOF**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121 also known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 (PDRRM Act of 2010)" mandates the creation of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council that shall uphold people's rights to life and property and shall adhere to internationally accepted principles, norms and standards in disaster risk reduction management and humanitarian assistance;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Mountain Province aligns itself to the national policy and adopts a holistic, comprehensive, integrated, pro-active and multi-sector approach in addressing the impacts of disaster and climate change;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RA 10121, the Provincial Government of Mountain Province is mandated to develop, promote and implement a comprehensive Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (PDRRMP) engaging the participation of non-government organizations, private sector and volunteers in disaster risk reduction;

**WHEREFORE**, by virtue of the power vested in me as the Chief Executive of the Provincial Government of Mountain Province, I, **BONIFACIO C. LACWASAN, JR.**, do hereby order the composition of the Mountain Province Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, enumerated as follows:

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE COUNCIL**

The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council shall have the following functions:

1. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (LDRRMP) and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;



2. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
3. Recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary;
4. Convene as often as necessary to effectively coordinate the efforts on disaster mitigation, preparedness, response/emergency operations, and rehabilitation activities;
5. Take the lead in preparing for, responding to and recovering from the effects of any disaster if two (2) or more municipalities are affected;
6. Call on other departments, bureaus, agencies, instrumentalities and corporations of the government and the private sector for assistance in preparing for, reacting to and recovering from the effects of disaster and civil emergencies;
7. Implement within the province the guidelines set by the RDRRMC and submits recommendations as necessary;
8. All members of the Council shall make available their personnel, facilities and expertise to effectively carry out the functions of the Council;
9. The Council shall discharge such other functions and duties which is necessary and directly related to its mandate, in consonance with the provision of R.A. No. 10121 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

### **SECTION 3. SCHEDULE OF MEETINGS**

The MPDRRMC shall convene at least once every quarter to be scheduled by the Chairperson and as often as necessary.

### **SECTION 4. MOUNTAIN PROVINCE DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS CENTER**

The facility known as the Mountain Province Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (MPDRRMOC), or simply "MP OpCen" located in Cadre Road, Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province shall serve as the Operating Facility of the MPDRRM Council. It shall be operated and maintained on a 24-hour basis by MPDRRMO personnel during normal situation to be complemented by the Detailed Duty Officers

(DDOs) from Council members during Emergency Condition (Blue and Red Alert).

In case the MP OpCen is rendered not functional due to disasters or calamities, the Sports Complex Building shall serve as the secondary MP Operations Center.

#### **SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY**

If any section or part of this Executive Order is held unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.


#### **SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE**

All orders, rules and regulations, issuances or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

#### **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and remains to be in full force and effective until superseded.
