MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**, made and entered into by and between:

The **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE**, a public tertiary educational institution, existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office address at Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province, represented by the College President, **EDGAR G. CUE**, **PhD.**, hereinafter referred to as the "**MPSPC**";

and

The BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION- MOUNTAIN PROVINCE DISTRICT JAIL (BJMP-MPDJ), a government agency organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Upper Caluttit, represented by its Warden, JSINSP BARTOLOME B. TRESMANIO, hereinafter referred to as the "BJMP-MPDJ";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, MPSPC is a duly recognized and accredited public higher educational institution by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) offering various degree programs and committed in the performance of its mandates alongside with instruction, research, and extension;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of the College to achieve its mission, one of which is to assist the country in the shared struggle for national development, **MPSPC** is extending its services and expertise through extension programs of each degree program;

WHEREAS, one of the Literacy Program of the **BJMP** is the implementation of **College Education Behind Bars (CEBB)** Program which helps to transform lives of Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) through education despite being incarcerated;

WHEREAS, to achieve the purpose of the CEBB Program, the MPDJ coordinated with the MPSPC for possible academic course to be offered to qualified PDL through online/face-to-face/modular classes under the supervision of Welfare and Development Officer;

WHEREAS, the **MPSPC**, through its Extension Program, is engaged in the development of their clients by providing trainings and relevant activities in response to the needs and demands of its clients;



WHEREAS, in support to the Bureau's CEBB Program, **MPSPC** endeavors to accommodate interested and qualified PDL of the MPDJ for college education through scholarship grants;

WHEREAS, BJMP- MPDJ recognizes the need to provide education to interested PDL who are willing to continue their college education while under the care of the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology;

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Development Goals adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as universal call to action to ensure inclusive and quality education and to recreate the global partnership and assure that by 2030, all youth and substantial proportion of adults, both men and women, achieve higher levels of education so that no one is left behind leading the involvement of MPSPC extension programs to build a strong reputation along with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's) on Quality Education and Partnership for the Goals.

WHEREAS, in pursuit of their respective mandates especially in the conduct of extension activities, the **MPSPC** and the **BJMP- MPDJ** both adhere to the significance of partnerships;

NOW, therefore, the MPSPC and the BJMP- MPDJ agree on the following:

ALL PARTIES shall:

- 1. Seek to identify a common working ground whereby sharing of resources and other collaborative means in order to improve the lives through education of the Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) of Mountain Province District Jail together with their professional growth and development through the implementation of the program; and
- 2. Share responsibility on providing supplies and materials needed during the implementation of the program and/or related extension activities where they are involved for the improvement of the joint venture.

THE MPSPC shall:

- 1. Conduct orientation to the qualified and interested PDL of the MPDJ regarding the courses to be offered and the availability of scholarship grants;
- 2. Facilitate the conduct of classes either modular, virtual or face-to-face among PDL-enrollees/students in coordination with the Unit Welfare and Development Officer;
- 3. Facilitators/instructors/professors to adhere with the BJMP rules and regulations such as submission to security checks and searches prior to entry in the jail;
- 4. Cooperate with the BJMP in its desire to free the jail of any irregular or illegal activities inside the jail;
- 5. Not to be permitted to take photographs, video or audio recordings or similar activity inside the jail premises. Any information or data obtained during the conduct of the class or activity shall be treated with utmost confidentiality and in accordance with the provisions of the Data Privacy Act; and

- 6. Serve as facilitators during the implementation of the CEBB Program and/or related extension activities; and
- 7. Grant service credits to faculty and staff who will serve as facilitators during the implementation of the program.

THE BJMP-MPDJ shall:

- 1. Identify their beneficiaries-clients for the implementation of the program;
- 2. Coordinate with the MPSPC for the schedule of classes of PDL-enrollees/students;
- 3. Exercise authority and discretion whether to allow or not the entry of any member/s of the MPSPC who refuse to abide by the jail policy, rules and regulations;
- 4. Assign a coordinator in the monitoring of the identified beneficiariesclients during the conduct of the program;
- 5. Ensure safety of the MPSPC facilitators/instructors/professors during the conduct of classes within the jail premises;
- 6. Reserve the right to change the time slot allotted and any changes or even cancel/suspend the classes whenever security situation of the facility so requires; and
- 7. Grant Time Allowance for Studying, Teaching and Mentoring (TASTM) benefits to PDL enrollees/students as well as PDL-mentors in accordance with the provisions of RA 10592.

TERM and TERMINATION

1. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon the signing of this document by both parties and shall be valid and enforceable for a period of five (5) years with the option for renewal at the end of the term unless earlier terminated by both parties or any either party for a good and sufficient cause.

In case of pre-termination of this agreement by one party, the party initiating the termination shall inform the other party at least one (1) month prior to the date of the effectivity of the termination.

Further, should a renewal be adopted, each party shall submit their intention for the renewal of this agreement through a formal notice to the other party fifteen (15) days prior to the end of the agreement.

All amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties.

2. GOVERNING LAW

The validity, construction, and interpretation of this Agreement and the rights and duties of both parties shall conform with the parties' internal rules and regulations and be governed by the existing laws of the Republic of the Philippines.
