

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT** made and executed by and between:

The **MOUNTAIN PROVINCE STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE**, a higher educational institution established by the virtue of Republic Act No. 7182, with principal office address at Poblacion, Bontoc, Mountain Province, represented by its College President, **DR. EDGAR G. CUE**, hereinafter referred to as the "**MPSPC**";

-and-

The **CENTRAL LUZON STATE UNIVERSITY**, an institution of higher learning established by the virtue of Republic Act No. 4067, with principal office address at Science City of Muñoz, Nueva Ecija, represented by its President, **DR. EDGAR A. ORDEN**, hereinafter referred to as the "**CLSU**";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, both are duly recognized and accredited public higher educational institutions by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) offering various degree programs and committed to the performance of its instruction, research, extension, and resource generation functions;

WHEREAS, both institutions remain steadfast in their commitment to quality education and excellence in the pursuit of their respective visions and mandates as stated in their charters;

WHEREAS, both institutions affirm and recognize the need for collaborative efforts and partnership in pursuit of their mandates;

WHEREAS, both parties have distinct areas of expertise and strengths which could be extended to one another;


WHEREAS, **CLSU** as a world-class National Research University for science and technology in agriculture and allied fields receives visitors from its international partners. As part of their local itinerary, they are toured in the Cordillera Region where **MPSPC** is located; and

WHEREAS, **MPSPC**, as the Host and Facilitator of **CLSU's** visit, is willing to provide utmost hospitality and provide other applicable assistance as may be determined by both parties;


NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby enter into this Memorandum of Agreement for collaboration and mutually agree to:

- 1. **MPSPC** and **CLSU**, collectively referred to as **PARTIES**, confirm this agreement set forth below to promote collective efforts through academic and research endeavors.

2. The parties agree to work on the following areas of cooperation:
- Student academic and cultural exchange;
 - Student internship in Agriculture at CLSU
 - Student immersion in the Social Sciences in MPSPC and CLSU
 - Faculty research collaboration in Teacher Education, Social Sciences, Agricultural Technology, Hospitality Management, and Engineering;
 - Extension Projects collaboration for faculty and non-teaching personnel; and
 - Joint facilitating of seminars and conferences in various areas of discipline.

CLSU SHALL:

- Allow its qualified students and faculty members in the Teacher Education, Social Sciences, Agricultural Technology, Hospitality Management, and Engineering to take part on the areas of cooperations stated;
- Determine and recommend faculty members who will be part of the adjunct faculty pool based on the request of MPSPC, subject to the approval of the concerned faculty members and without prejudice to the discharge of their official duties and responsibilities at CLSU; and
- Recommend other measures to implement the MPSPC-CLSU partnership program.

MPSPC SHALL:

- Provide local hospitality as HOST and FACILITATOR of CLSU's international visitors and partners who visit the Cordillera Region; in recognized tourist spots in the province thru its hospitality and tourism programs.
- Identify faculty researchers in Education and Social Sciences, faculty experts in Curriculum, Indigenous Education and Indigenous Knowledge, Systems, and Practices to take part on the collaboration; and
- Allow the use of MPSC Montañosa Coffee Center and Congressman Victor S. Dominguez Research and Extension Development Center as experiment station in Agriculture.

EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

- Effectivity Date:** This Agreement shall take effect from the date of signing and shall remain to be effective unless terminated by either party.


2. **Termination:** Either party may terminate this agreement provided that the objectives of the project were met and a written notice of termination is delivered to the other party within a period of thirty (30) days before the intended termination.
3. **Dispute Settlement:** The Parties shall exert their best efforts to amicably settle any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement. In case of failure to amicably settle such disputes, any and all actions or suits shall be filed with or instituted with the proper courts, to the exclusion of all other venues.
4. **Amendments:** Any revisions, amendments, repeals, and supplements to this Agreement shall be made upon mutual written agreement by the Parties.
5. **Separability:** If any one of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect under any applicable law, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.
6. **Counterparts:** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same understanding. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Understanding.
