**II. NARRATIVE REPORT**

The primary aim of Institutional Marketing is to raise awareness to graduates of the k-12 curriculum of the Department of Education from various secondary schools who will eventually decide on their next journey towards achieving their career goals and those who opt to pursue tertiary education. This Institutional Marketing will help them in their decision making by providing them relevant information on the different services and programs which the college offers and to orient them on the free access to higher education, scholarships and grants, and other privileges and opportunities they might enjoy when they decided to enroll in the institution.

The team that conducted the Institutional marketing was divided into 3 group for group 1, Sadanga and Bontoc, the institutional marketing was conducted by Mr. Jay B. Napanoy Coordinator for Alumni Relations and Job Placement, Mr. Glen C. Gayagay Coordinator for Student Organization, Ms. Crystine C. Group 3, the team of Mr. Jason Imatong Dean, for student Service, Mr. Philip L. Balagtey coordinator for Campus Ministry, Mr. Mark N. Nawen from criminology Instructor, Ms. Allyza forayang from TED Instructor and Mr. Ariel Joseph A. Fantiyao went to Barlig, Natonin and Paracelis.

On April 3 to 4 the team of Mr. Jason E. Imatong Dean, Student Services and development depart at around 9:00 am from the College to Barlig.
